

Board of Appeals Hearing January 12, 2008 10:00 a.m.

Chairman Bob Fraik called the Town of Peshtigo Board of Appeals meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Board of Appeals members present were Bob Fraik, Tim Kodric, Jim Kollross, Ed Kowalski, Patricia Pottratz, and Gerald Pennings.

Also present were Carla Golueke, Jim and Linda Larson.

Kowalski, Kodric, and Fraik all expressed an interest in continuing on the board when their terms are complete at the end of January 2008.

Fraik announced that he would not be voting because all members of the board were present.

New members Pottratz and Kollross were given their Oath of Office.

A motion was made by Pennings and seconded by Kollross to amend the agenda to include approving the minutes of the September 9, 2006 meeting as printed. The motion carried with all in favor.

A request is made by Carla Golueke, N2511 Krause Road, to locate an accessory building in an area other than what is allowed in Town zoning.

The Larsons were given an opportunity to speak and said there were no objections to the placement of the proposed accessory building.

After all were heard, the hearing was closed and the Board of Appeals took action on the variance request.

A motion was made by Pottratz and seconded by Kodric to grant the variance per the ordinance which states an unnecessary hardship exists for the property owner. A roll call vote was taken and the motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Pennings and seconded by Kodric to adjourn the meeting at 10:18 a.m. The motion carried with all in favor.
