

**March 4, 2010 Town of Peshtigo Board Meeting 2:45 p.m.**

Town Board meeting was called to order at 2:45 p.m.

Town Clerk Clarence E. Coble was excused. Cindy Hagert recorded minutes of the meeting.

**Agenda Approval:** Motion (Karen Sylvester/Mark Monnette) to approve the agenda. Motion carried with 4 yes votes.

**Road Projects for 2010:** Mark Monnette showed a list of proposed road projects for the year including: Richter Road in its entirety approximately 1 mile by 16 feet wide. Pulverize, shape, fine grade. 2" after compaction hot mix asphalt 1 foot by 2 inch thick limestone shoulder each side.

Country Meadows Road from RR track apron to Old Peshtigo Road approximately 141' by 20'. Pulverize and remove material so new lay will match Old Peshtigo Road grade and the entrance grade for the Shell gas station. Fine grade and lay 3" after compaction hot mix asphalt in 2 lifts.

Weigers Road .23 mile long. Pulverize and fine grade 17' by 2" after compaction hot mix or cold mix asphalt. 1' shoulder each side of topsoil and gravel mix compacted to blend lawn to road bed.

McFadden Road .51 mile. Reshape, add gravel as needed. Pave 20' by 2" after compaction hot mix or cold mix asphalt. Add 2' limestone shoulders each side. This will also include cul-de-sac at the termini per Town standards.

Deer Lake Road prepare road bed per Town standards for future blacktopping.

Edgewood Drive would be the next road to work on if changes arise from the original proposal.

Motion (Karen Sylvester/Dan Staudenmaier) to authorize to advertise for bids for road work listed. Motion carried with 4 yes votes.

**Authorize for Bids for Removal of Trees Along Town Roads:** Discussion was had on the removal of trees. A handout entitled "Vegetation in the Highway Right of Way" was available listing some guidelines. The Town crew has finished marking the potential trees involved. Mark Monnette suggested that each road be looked at and make recommendations as to which trees are involved. These will be located by fire numbers. Property owners may cut trees on their property but they will be responsible for any downed wires or damage.

Motion (Karen Sylvester/Mark Monnette) to authorize to advertise for bids for the removal of trees on a project basis. These bids should come back to the Board by the April 20, 2010 meeting. Motion carried with 4 yes votes.

**Discussion of the Roundabout on Schacht Road:** Copies of the letters from the truck companies in the industrial park along with a letter from the Town opposing the roundabout will be sent to Steve Noel, Tim Stumm, Dave Hansen and John Nygren. The Town is concerned about the pressure from the DOT regarding building the roundabout and insisting that the Town take over that section of roads.

**Culvert Problem on Dahl Road:** Mark Monnette reported that a culvert on Dahl Road near Kutz Road will have gravel added to the top of the culvert this week. This is a short term solution and the culvert may have to be removed and replaced with similar fill.

**Discussion/Action on use of Multi-Modal Lane on New Highway 41 Peshtigo River Bridge:** The local snowmobile clubs would like to use the new bridge to tie into the trail system with Oconto and Marinette. Even though the Town of Peshtigo does not own the bridge, Marinette County and the WIDOT won't give their OK for use until the Town does. It was decided that property owners along the bridge need to be addressed on this issue personally to find out where the owners stand.

Motion by (Karen Sylvester/Mark Monnette) to adjourn the meeting at 3:55 p.m. Motion carried with 4 yes votes.
