17 Town residents were in attendance for the 2010 annual meeting.

Annual meeting was chaired by Herman Pottratz Town Chairperson.

Meeting attendees were reminded that they need to be a Town Resident to be eligible to vote at the meeting.

Treasurer Vilas Schroeder presented the Town financial report for 2009.

Motion by (Ed Sedor/Pat Ravet) to approve the 2009 annual meeting minutes. Motion carried with unanimous votes.

Motion by (Pat Ravet/Ed Sedor) to approve the 2009 Financial Report. Motion carried with unanimous vote.

Motion by (Ed Sedor/Bryan Peth) to authorize the Town Board to sell surplus equipment. Motion carried with unanimous vote.

Motion by (Bryan Peth/Pat Ravet) to call a town meeting when the 2011 budget is ready for approval. Motion carried with unanimous vote.

1. We lost Joe Kiefer and Joanne Seidl. Joe was a supervisor and Joanne was the Town Clerk.
2. The 41 Bypass was completed and Karen Sylvester gave an excellent speech at the dedication.
3. The Town Board held the Town tax.
4. Code of Ordinances was completed.
5. Town Hall maintenance contract was signed with Jill Bedwell, I Kleen.
6. Snowplowing contract with private contractor was signed with Jim Wortner, Road King Excavating.
7. A used one ton Town truck and plow with salt spreader was purchased.
8. Retires:
 - (a) Ken Johnston worked at the recycling center and Town hall and also mowed along Town roads.
 - (b) Grace Pennings after 33 years with the fire department. She will serve on the Fire Commission.
 - (c) Karen Sylvester as Supervisor #3 and Board vice chairman. Karen took part in every project that the Town had for 14 years. She will continue as chairman of the Plan Commission and advisor to the Town Board.

One accomplishment that is happening this year is working on the phragmites problem on the bay. This problem has been turned over to Bob Fraik and Chuck Boyle and if everything goes well in Madison today, Phragmites shouldn't be such a problem. Through their efforts permits should no longer be needed to clean the shoreline. Also a grant has been received to spray the shoreline to Oconto. Hopefully, this will work and solve the problems.

We will have Denise Wiedemeier as Supervisor #3 to replace Karen. She will do a great job.
