

## **May 13, 2014 Town of Peshtigo Fire Commission**

Chairman Bill Johnson called the meeting of the Town of Peshtigo Fire Commission to order at 6:00 p.m. and roll call was taken.

Present: Alex Dudka, Bill Johnson, and Lou Ann Seils.

Absent: Grace Pennings and Don Wahl.

Also attending were Mike Folgert and Rich Seils.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Seils to approve the agenda as printed. The motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Seils to approve the minutes of the Sept 30, 2013 meeting as printed. The motion carried with all in favor.

Mike Folgert introduced Nikkee Dionne as the new Deputy Clerk for the Town of Peshtigo.

A motion was made by Johnson to nominate Lou Ann Seils as Chairperson and seconded by Dudka. The motion was carried with all in favor. Seils nominated Dudka for Vice chair, Johnson seconded it with all in favor.

A new Automatic Aid Agreement has been drafted between the Town of Peshtigo Fire Dept. and the City of Marinette Fire Dept. The agreement states that an automatic dispatch of a Marinette Fire Dept. engine, along with Town of Peshtigo Fire Dept. to all structure fires within a predefined geographic area of the Town of Peshtigo that are in close proximity to the city of Marinette. Both Town Board and City Common Council approvals are needed

Mike Folgert presented the new ISO rating for the Town of Peshtigo Fire Department. The fire Dept. has gone from a class 7 to a class 6 effective August 1, 2014 for all properties within 5 miles of the fire station.

Mike Folgert stated the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary Picnic is planned for June 21, 2014 from 11-4. New uniforms with the new logo will be presented along with a pig roast and live band.

There was no old business.

The Fire Chief Reported they sold the mini pumper and took possession of Brush Truck 1. The annual inspection of the Trucks is scheduled for June 18<sup>th</sup>. Engine 205 is 20 years old and had major repair work recently done to extend the use of its life to 30 years.

The next meeting will be scheduled as needed.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Seils to adjourn the meeting at 7:05 p.m. The motion carried with all in favor.
