**NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF A RESOLUTION TO VACATE AND DISCONTINUE
LEA ROAD IN THE TOWN OF PESHTIGO, MARINETTE COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town Board of the Town of Peshtigo, Marinette County, Wisconsin, will hold a public hearing on **March 2, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. (noon)** or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Town Hall, W2435 Old Peshtigo Road, Marinette, WI 54143 on the proposed adoption of a Resolution herein described. Said Resolution proposes discontinuance and vacation of Lea Road as described below, pursuant to Wis. Stat Sec. 66.1003(4)(a). This Resolution was introduced at the Town Board meeting held on December 10, 2020. The Resolution will be considered and acted upon at the date and time for the public hearing set forth above.

Lea Road, the town highway to be discontinued, is more fully described as follows:

Part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 29 North, Range 23 East, Town of Peshtigo, Marinette County, Wisconsin, that is further described below:

A 49.5-foot-wide roadway, the centerline of which is described as follows:

From the Northeast Corner of said Section 4, measure S02°54'53"E, 1334.74 feet along the East Line of said Section 4; thence S81°52'12"W, 803.38 feet to the Westerly Right of Way of County Trunk Highway "BB" (C.T.H. "BB"); thence Southeasterly 27.03 feet along said right of way, along the arch of a 914.47 foot radius curve to the left, having a chord bearing S22°35'48"E, 27.03 feet to the Point of Beginning of said centerline; thence Southwesterly, 57.34 feet along the arch of a 75.00 foot radius curve to the left, having a chord bearing S36°10'36"W, 55.95 feet; thence S14°16'26"W, 537.67 feet; thence S20°41'38"W, 349.25 feet; thence S26°11'28"W, 347.12 feet; thence S09°49'53"W, 118.24 feet to the Northwest Corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and the Point of Ending.

A map showing the location of the highway to be discontinued is available at the Town Hall.

All interested parties will be given an opportunity to be heard at said meeting.
