Training:

- An After-Action-Review was conducted for the Sal B Scrap Metal Recycling Fire that occurred on May 9-10th
- Annual Hose testing started on June 20th with 83 lengths of hose (4,150 ft.) tested so far.

Special Events:

- June 7th – Life Saving Awards were presented to 3 firefighters and Unit Commendation Awards to 5 firefighters at a City of Peshtigo Council meeting for their efforts in rescuing three jet skiers from the Peshtigo River last month.
- June 11th – We participated in the veteran's and First Responder Appreciation Day at Badger Park. We had fire apparatus on display and conducted our gun raffle drawing.

Personnel:

- One new firefighter applicant is going through medical testing.
- Our active firefighter roster stands at 25 volunteers.
